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The Graduate Certificate for Instructional Design & Educational Technology intended to provide instructional designers and P-12 educators with core knowledge about the processes involved in the design, development and integration of technology-based instructional media, methods and systems. This certificate will provide educators with foundational knowledge about the instructional design process by integrating research from behavioral psychology, cognitive psychology, learning theories, arts-based and critical/cultural theoretical perspectives of teaching and learning. Through the sequence of courses, learners will integrate the theoretical foundations within the methods of design, integration, and formative and summative evaluation. This certificate is appropriate for both active P-12 practitioners seeking professional development and individuals who aspire to hold positions that require knowledge of instructional design for education and training.
